I spoke with Chris Salas from the Town of Florence. He is in favor of the FYA signal heads (Type G) for the single-lane left-turn movements for the eastbound, westbound, and southbound approaches. He would like to keep the R head for the protected only dual left-turn lanes.

I have marked up the plans (see attached) to show that six (6) Q heads will be replaced with G heads. The two (2) R heads will remain, and the two (2) Q heads will remain for the eastbound right-turn movement.
